

Organization of Instruction

The district shall provide a system of education extending from kindergarten through grade 12. It also is responsible for special education for handicapped children and home instruction for students who need it.

The schools of the district shall be organized to present a unified program of instruction and shall be operated as a single system under the direction of the superintendent.

The grouping and housing of instructional levels in school facilities shall be in accordance with what is called the K-4, 5, 6-8, 9-12 plan. Under this plan, the kindergarten and grade 1 will be the primary school, grades 2, 3, 4, and 5 will be the elementary schools; the intermediate school will contain grades 6, 7 and 8, and the senior high school will contain grades 9, 10, 11 and 12.
